ACTIVITY UPDATE:

The month of March has been "Training" month for the police department.

March 3rd – 7th Officer Mercer attended Field Training Officer School. She will be our trainer for any new hires at the department. Upon her return, she redesigned the FTO program that we have been using to bring us up to date and will in turn reduce our liability overall in regards to training.

March 10th Chief Lambka attended training in Asset Forfeiture. The Michigan Statute allows us to seize and file forfeiture proceedings on assets of drug violators as well as some drunken driving arrests. We have never had a good understanding of the procedure that we need to follow in these matters. This class has helped us streamline the process and create another tool for us to in the war against drugs. These assets can then be used by the department to fund drug enforcement efforts by our department.

March 11th and 12th Charity Wright attended Property Room Management. She will be taking over the day to day management of our Evidence and Property room. She is working to develop current policies and procedures to bring us up to date and make processing evidence more efficient.

March 14th Chief Lambka attending Crime Scene Operations School. This course was designed to help us develop a Crime Scene Policy and Procedure. We are currently relying heavily on LCSO and MSP Crime Scene Technicians to help us process crime scenes. We will be bringing in trainers from Kalamazoo Department of Public Safety Forensic Laboratory to teach us how to collect and process our own crime scenes. This training will also be offered to other smaller agencies within the county and will be provided at no cost to our departments.

March 31st and April 1st Officer Escott attended Standardized Field Sobriety training. This training is required to participate in the grant funded OWI enforcements that we participate in throughout the year. It is also a very valuable tool for assessing drunk drivers during a traffic stop.

NEW OFFICER UPDATE

Officer Randy Escott was sworn in on March 20th. He is currently training with Officer Mercer in our newly designed FTO program. Randy is from the Britton – Macon area and is anxious to get on his own. Randy is doing very well with his training and we expect to have him ready to go by the end of May.
