ACTIVITY UPDATE:

The month of April has been busy with bad checks, assault related, and malicious destruction of property complaints.

Officer Mercer is seeking warrants on an individual for 12 felony counts of writing checks on a closed account in which they cheated township merchants out of thousands of dollars.

Officer Mercer is also seeking misdemeanor warrants on an individual who wrote two NSF checks to an area merchant.

On 4/22/08 Officer Escott was conducting a sex offender registration sweep when he discovered that a sex offender within the township had supplied a fictitious address when registering with the state and his whereabouts is unknown. Officer Escott has sought a felony warrant on the suspect and is continuing his investigation on the suspect.

On 4/27/08 Officer Mercer stopped a car for a traffic violation and ended up with a narcotics related arrest. She found \$2100 in cash concealed on the driver. A narcotics dog was requested to the scene from Adrian City Police Dept. The dog alerted to the presence of narcotics on the money and in the vehicle. As a result, Officer Mercer forfeited the money and the vehicle under the narcotics forfeiture act.

On 4/30/08 Officer Mercer responded to a report of a felonious assault. During a heated argument, a male suspect pointed a loaded handgun at his wife's head and threatened to shoot her. She was able to lock herself in a bathroom until officers arrived. He had fled the scene and was later arrested in the Hudson area.

NEW HIRE UPDATE:

Officer Escott is more than half way through his training program and is doing well. We expect him to be out on his own by the end of May.

We conducted Oral Interviews for police candidates on April 29th. We interviewed 8 candidates out of 24 applications. We have narrowed the finalists down to three outstanding individuals. We are now conducting background investigations and doing final interviews. We hope to have a recommendation to the board by the next board meeting.

RESERVE OFFICER PROGRAM:

Bob Mercer and Chief Lambka have been working together on organizing a Reserve Program for the township. We have a solid group of experienced people that are interested seeing this program take off. We have attached a copy of the rules and regulations as well as the department policy needed to create this program. This will be an all volunteer group of individuals who are dedicated to assisting the department and providing a service to the community.

Board approval is requested before we continue with this program.
