

Police Department Report

The following is a summary of activity for the Raisin Township Police Department for the month of April.

Significant Activity:

A warrant was issued in the embezzlement case of lottery tickets from Hubie's Market by an employee. She has been arrested and is currently lodged at the LCJ awaiting her next court hearing. The estimated amount embezzled was between \$200,000 and \$300,000.

Our department is still waiting for warrants to be issued on our arson investigation. This case is still being reviewed by the County Prosecutor.

We are currently working a stolen motorcycle case and hope to have warrants issued on that this week.

Our Officers are working with the FBI on the stolen dump truck, bulldozer and trailer case reported last month. It appears that this theft was part of a multi-state theft ring. I will provide you with more details as they become available.

Narcotics tips are increasing rapidly within the township. We are working with OMNI on several leads. We are committed to making Raisin Township as drug free as possible. We would ask that if a resident of Raisin Township notices any suspicious activity, call us with that information to assist us in the war on drugs.

Training:

Chief Lambka and Officer Wright attended a Basic Narcotics Investigators course in Garden City from April 3rd thru April 14th. This course was sponsored by the DEA and there was no charge for us to attend. This is one of the top investigators courses available.

Chief Lambka, Sgt. Poe and Officer Wright attended the Street Crimes seminar held at the Tecumseh Civic Center on April 24th thru the 26th. This class was sponsored by the Lenawee Jackson Training Consortium. The topics were geared at street level investigative techniques and officer safety/ survival.
