

**THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE
RAISIN TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE # 115-01**

It is the purpose of this Ordinance to promote the safety, health and welfare for the general public.

UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE

CODE ADOPTED. The Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages promulgated by the Director of State Police and published in the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code and Amendments as published in the Quarterly Supplement No. 5 to the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative code and thereafter, in accordance with Public Act 1956, State of Michigan, is hereby adopted by reference, as in this ordinance modified, for the purpose of regulating traffic in the Raisin Township.

CODE ON FILE. Complete printed copies of the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages, herein adopted, shall be available for public use and inspection at the office of the Township Clerk.

NOTICE TO BE PUBLISHED. The Township Clerk shall publish this ordinance in the manner required by law and shall at the same time publish a supplementary notice setting for the purpose of the said Uniform Traffic Code and the fact that a complete copy of the Code is available at the office of the Clerk for inspection by the public at all times.

REFERENCES IN CODE. References in the Uniform Traffic Code Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages to "governmental unit" shall mean the Raisin Township.

CONFLICTING ORDINANCES REPEALED. All other ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of the Uniform Traffic Code are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

CIVIL PENALTY. The maximum civil penalty for a violation of the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships and Villages, as amended, that is designated a civil infraction shall be \$250.00, plus court costs.

MISDEMEANOR PENALTY. The maximum penalty for a violation of the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships and Villages, as amended, that is designated a misdemeanor shall be imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of not more than \$500.00, or both, plus court costs and the costs of prosecution.

This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days after publication.

The foregoing Ordinance was approved by the Township Board at a special meeting on
June 21, 2001
