

Police Department Report

The following is a summary of activity for the Raisin Township Police Department for the month of May.

Significant Activity:

Our department is still waiting for warrants to be issued on our arson investigation. The County Prosecutor is having this case reviewed by an arson expert.

We have recovered a stolen motorcycle as part of a recent investigation. Warrants are pending.

Our department has concluded a seven month investigation into the breaking and entering of a township residence. Two arrests were made and both suspects remain lodged at the Lenawee County Jail awaiting trial.

Traffic Enforcement:

Both of the new cars are in service and working well. Our traffic enforcement car was featured at the Tecumseh Memorial day parade. We have received many compliments on both cars and we are very happy with the way the cars turned out. Traffic enforcement is a high priority this summer especially on race weekends do to the anticipated high traffic counts expected because of the US 223 construction project. We will be concentrating on, not only the main thoroughfares, but the residential sections as well.

May kicked off the 2006 Seatbelt and OWI enforcement for 2006. We will be participating in grant funded enforcement zones within the county. All overtime is paid for by this grant. A seatbelt enforcement was held in raisin Township during the last week of May.

Training:

Officer Wright attended a Juvenile Justice seminar on May 4th that was held at the Maurice Spear Campus and sponsored by the Lenawee County Juvenile Court Division.

Officer Wright and Sgt. Poe attended an auto theft class on May 16th which was sponsored by the Lenawee/ Jackson Training Consortium and held at the Tecumseh Fire Department.

Officer Wright attended a firearm legal update held at the Lenawee County Sheriff's Office on May 12th.
