

Police Department Report

The following is a summary of activity for the Raisin Township Police Department for the month of December.

Significant Activity:

Officers have enjoyed a drop in violent crime activity within the township this month. The majority of the complaints have been traffic related. We are continuing to follow up on leads related to tool thefts within the county as well as the township.

On December 4th and 5th Sgt. Poe and Officer Wright attended Forensic Interview training at the Napoleon Police Department.

On December 19th and 20th all department officers attended QUAD training at Siena Heights College Campus. This training is for officers responding to an active shooter in a school or industrial complex. This training brings multiple departments together to practice working with each other in a larger scale response. Everyone benefited from this training and we were happy to have been invited to attend.

During the month of December, Chief Lambka attended CPR and First Aid instructor training with the American Red Cross. He will be instructing police officers in these areas as part of their annual recertification process. This training was paid for and sponsored by the regional training consortium.

Traffic Related

We are happy to report that we did not have any drunken driving arrests this holiday season.

We continue to see a high incident of car deer accidents with 11 reported this month. The mild weather has kept the deer very active.
