

Police Department Report

The following is a summary of activity for the Raisin Township Police Department for the month of September.

Significant Activity:

Township Officers have developed some new leads in the recent thefts of off road vehicles stolen from the township and the county in general. With the assistance of the Woodstock Police Department, one stolen 4 wheeler has been recovered.

On September 19th, Officer Wright responded to a burglary alarm at Hubie's Market. When he arrived, he saw that someone had gained entry into the business and called for back up. Officer's checked the building but the suspect had escaped. The suspect's escape route was tracked by the LCSO K-9 unit to a nearby residence. We are reviewing security camera footage to help identify the suspect.

Township Officers continue to investigate multiple larcenies and burglaries within the township. We would like to ask all township residence to help us by notifying us if they notice anything suspicious in their neighborhood. If we all work together, we can put a stop to these criminals.

Car Deer accidents have increased this month. Please use caution during the coming weeks.

Traffic Enforcement:

Township Officers participated in an OWI (drunk driver) enforcement initiative in the Township on September 1st and 3rd.

We have received multiple requests for extra patrols on Ridge Highway. Residents report a high number of near misses while pulling from or into their driveways due to the excessive speed on that stretch of road. Officers wrote 16 speeding tickets on Ridge Hwy. last month in response to these requests.
